αὐτός

1. As a pronoun

- a) In nominative (any position)
 In any case as first word
 - = EMPHATIC (ipse)

αὐτὸς ἀφίκετο he arrived himself αύτὸς άφικόμην I myself arrived

- In other cases (not first word) = 'him, her, it' (eum) εἶδον αὐτην I saw her
 (but αὐτην εἶδον it was she that I saw)
- c) Often in genitive = possessive, non-reflexive, outside sandwich εἶδον την μητερα αὐτου I saw her mother

2. As an adjective

- a) Outside sandwich = ipse αὐτον τον βασιλεα the king himself τον βασιλεα αὐτον the king himself
- b) Inside sandwich = idem ὁ αὐτος βασιλευς the same king
