

Examples of the infinitive in indirect constructions

οὐ μέντοι οἶμαι ἥξειν αὐτὸ τήμερον.

However, I do not think it will come today.

ὥς ἔγωγε καὶ ὑπὲρ σοῦ καὶ ὑπὲρ ἡμῶν τῶν σῶν ἐπιτηδείων αἰσχύνομαι μὴ δόξη ἅπαν
τὸ πρᾶγμα τὸ περὶ σὲ ἀνανδρίᾳ τινὶ τῇ ἡμετέρᾳ πεπραῆχθαι

*So I am shamed both for you and for us, your friends, and I am afraid people will think that
this whole affair of yours has been conducted with a sort of cowardice on our part*
